

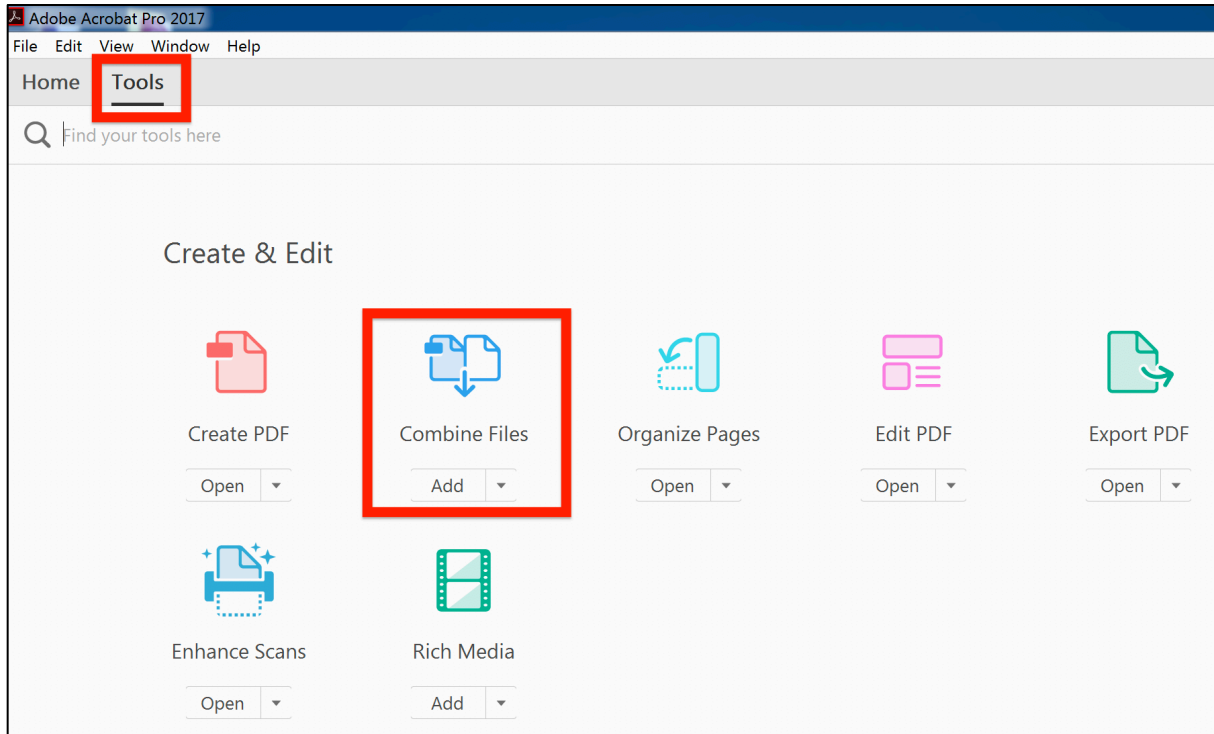
This tutorial shows step-by-step on how to combine multiple PDF files into one single PDF file using **Adobe Acrobat**, **Nitro PDF**, or **PDF-XChange Editor**.

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Combining multiple PDFs using Adobe Acrobat

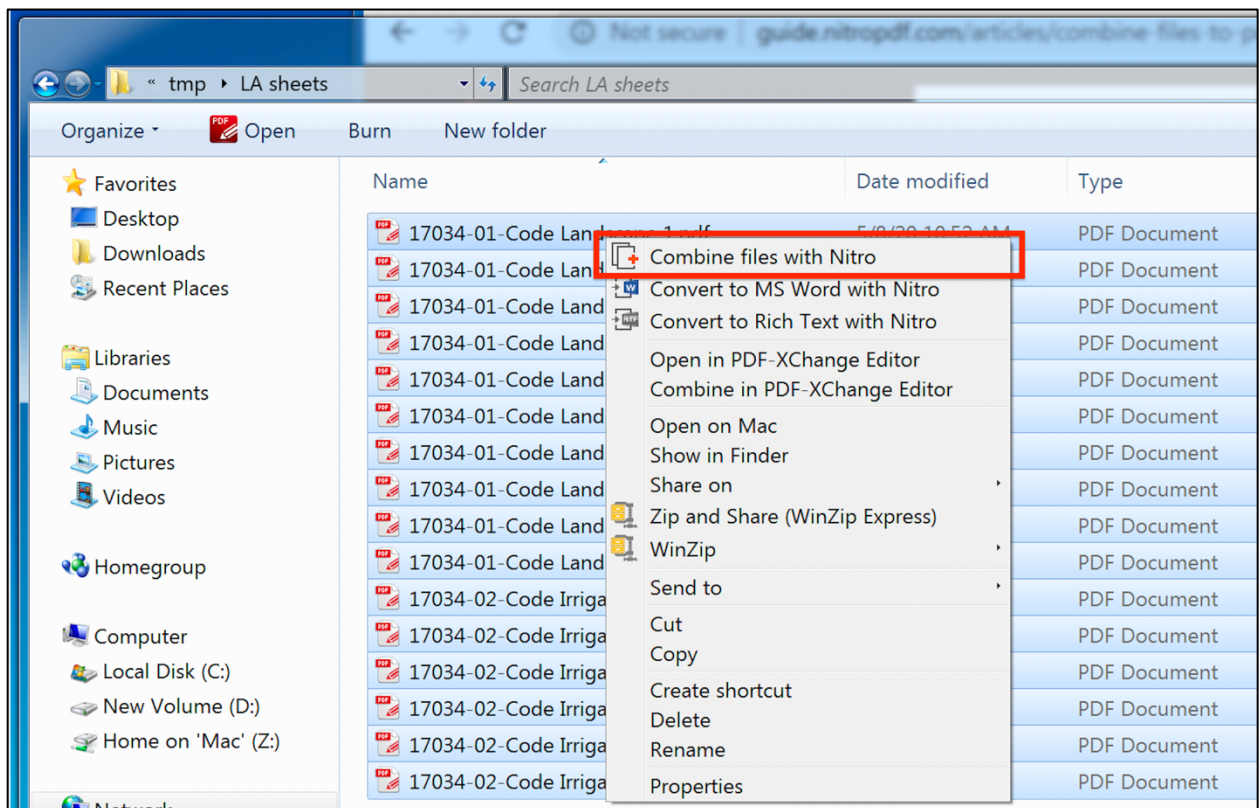
1. Open Adobe Acrobat to combine files: Open the **Tools** tab and select "**Combine files.**"



2. Click "**Add Files**" and select the files you want to include in your PDF.
3. Click "**Combine Files**".
4. Save as a PDF file: Name your file and click the "**Save**" button. That's it.

Combine multiple PDFs using Nitro PDF

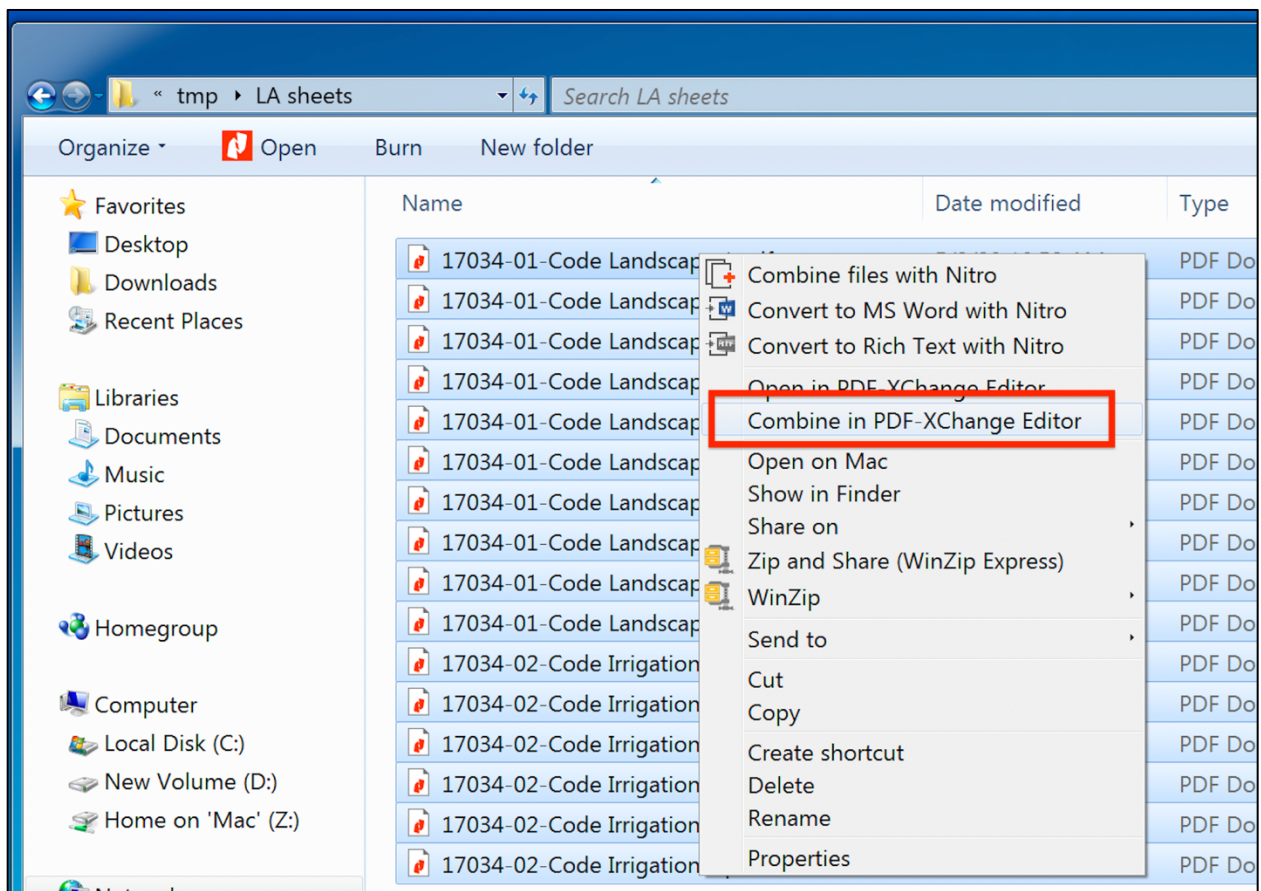
1. Download and install Nitro PDF from <https://www.gonitro.com/>
2. On your computer, open the folder that contains the PDF files you want to combine
3. Select all the PDF files you want to merge into one PDF file
4. Right-click, and then choose **Combine files with Nitro**



5. Click Move Up and Move Down to reorder the files as desired
6. In the Make PDF files list, click **Web-ready**
7. In the Save PDF to list, select the location you want to save the file to and click Create

Combine multiple PDFs using PDF-XChange Editor

1. Download and install PDF-Xchange Editor from <https://www.tracker-software.com/product/pdf-xchange-editor>
2. On your computer, open the folder that contains the PDF files you want to combine
3. Select all the PDF files you want to merge into one PDF file
4. Right-click, and then choose Combine in **PDF-Xchange Editor**



5. Click **File > Save As...** to choose a name and location to save the combined PDF
